The Delta Flight Museum seeks to hire a Simulator Operator. The Operator, reporting to the Museum Supervisor, will be responsible for running the simulator experience with visitors and working with Delta Air Lines' Simulator Maintenance department to maintain the simulator and related equipment. The Operator will also be cross-trained to answer visitor questions, work events as needed, and properly clean museum exhibitions.

The ideal candidate is a patient, self-motivated individual with excellent communication and customer service skills. This ideal candidate will also have availability to work various shifts and timeslots throughout the week. Most shift will fall in the 8:30am-3pm timeframe, with the occasional evening shift with events. The qualified individual will be retired from the airline industry or general aviation having worked with simulators as either maintenance or instructor.
